Page & Sons Wine Merchants began in the year before the Battle of Trafalgar whilst England was fighting the Napoleonic Wars. At that time Ramsgate was the port from which troops and stores sailed to the Continent. The Duke of Wellington (then Sir Arthur Wellesley) stayed with his Headquarters staff at the London Hotel in Ramsgate (the site now occupied by the HSBC Bank), which was owned by Robert Page and his younger brother Richard. At that time, there was a threat of invasion by Napoleon and among those caught up in the invasion scare was a grocer named Fisher. He offered his shop on the corner of Harbour Street and Market Place for sale and hastily left the town. The Iron Duke had taken a liking to young Richard, then just 24, and advised him to buy the empty grocer's shop. Richard took his advice and invested his life savings in the new venture in 1804, establishing a business which has been passed on from father to son for seven generations. Like all businesses, market trends have altered and each generation has adapted to the needs of the day. After a while, the firm expanded and moved into new premises at 2, 4 and 6 Queen Street which boasted some quite magnificent cellars in which the firm carried out the bottling of many wines such as Vintage Ports and Sherries etc as well as beers.

CHAPEL DOWN

Based in Tenterden in Kent, the Chapel Down winery has some of the best winemaking facilities in England, with a geology and climate that is very suitable for making World Class sparkling wines and unique, light fresh still wines. They are expanding their capacity all the time and can produce over 1 million bottles of still and sparkling wines.

English wines and Chapel Down in particular have been winning critical acclaim and wide recognition for the last ten years.

HUSH HEATH

Hidden deep in the Garden of England near Staplehurst in Kent, the Hush Heath Estate is home to award winning English wines. The Estate comprises 400 acres of perfectly manicured vineyards, apple orchards and ancient oak woodlands rich with wildlife, flora and fauna all of which add to the beauty and provenance of what they produce. Since its beginnings, the Estate has grown its product range substantially and now boasts an exquisite selection of wines and ciders all produced from fruit grown in their beautiful vineyards and apple orchards.

What started as a hobby for entrepreneur Richard Balfour-Lynn is now a quickly expanding family based wine and cider business.

WESTWELL

Westwell is a small 13 acre vineyard located between Westwell and Charing in Kent. They plant Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes for sparkling wine and Ortega for the still wines. The grapes are all hand picked to ensure only the best fruit is selected and their fully equipped winery is designed specifically for producing aromatic still whites and fine sophisticated sparkling wines using one of the most gentle presses available.

This wine has tropical fruit salad aromas and a zesty fresh palate which is light bodied and easy drinking with a crisp finish.

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A pleasant, balanced, harmonious and fruity wine of good structure with floral notes and hints of pear and apricot.

ORTEGA CLASSIC FERMENT	WESTWELL WINES, KENT, ENGLAND	£3.75	£5.15	£7.45	£21.95
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Fermented in stainless steel and aged for 6 months, this medium bodied wine has honeysuckle, grapefruit and peaches on the nose leading to a rounded dry finish with hints of lychees and melon.

SKYE'S ENGLISH CHARDONNAY	HUSH HEATH ESTATE, KENT, ENGLAND				£24.95
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This wine is 'England's answer to Chablis' being 100% Chardonnay. It has aromas of citrus, thyme and pineapple with a lively acidity and flavours of ripe grapefruit, citrus and apple.

RIVERSDALE MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC	NEW ZEALAND				£26.95
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This luscious wine combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh fruit to provide a full palate and lingering finish.

COTES DU RHONE RESERVE	DOMAINE GRAND VENEUR, FRANCE				£29.95
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Golden yellow in colour with white flowers and exotic fruits on the nose. Dry, medium bodied with elegant flavours and a hint of white peach.

RED

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Juicy and enjoyable with blackcurrant pastille, blackberry and tutti frutti flavours. The palate has well balanced tannins and is soft and approachable.

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A full bodied, well balanced, intensely coloured wine with aromas of violets and a fruity taste.

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Barrel aged for at least 12 months, this rich, vibrant wine has red fruit aromas and softly integrated oak. It is broad on the palate with soft, well structured tannins and a rounded, long finish.

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A medium bodied, dry wine with mellow tannins and strong impressions of dark fruits on the nose and palate.

MONTAGNE ST EMILION AC	VIEUX CHATEAU NEGRIT, YVON MAU, FRANCE				£26.95
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A deep coloured wine with balanced ripe, red fruit aromas with some cedar tones, a touch of black pepper and soft tannins.

GIGONDAS AC	DOMAINES CABASSIERES, FRANCE				£29.95
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Black red in colour, well balanced, rich and generous with a powerful aroma of dried and black fruits and hints of cedarwood.

ROSÉ

PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ VENEZIE IGT	SAN GIORGIO, ITALY	£4.55	£6.45	£18.95	
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A crisp wine, fresh and well balanced on the palate with pleasant fruity fragrances of cherries.

NANNETTE'S ENGLISH ROSE	HUSH HEATH ESTATE, KENT, ENGLAND				£24.95
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This is a pale pink wine with aromas of strawberries, pink grapefruit and orchard fruits, the palate is light and refreshing with hints of strawberry, apple and citrus with a vibrant acidity.

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An extra dry, fruity Italian sparkling wine with good intensity.

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A crisp, dry sparkling white wine, pale lemon in colour with notes of apple and lemongrass on the nose. It is finely structured with flavours of fresh citrus and hints of strawberry on the finish.
